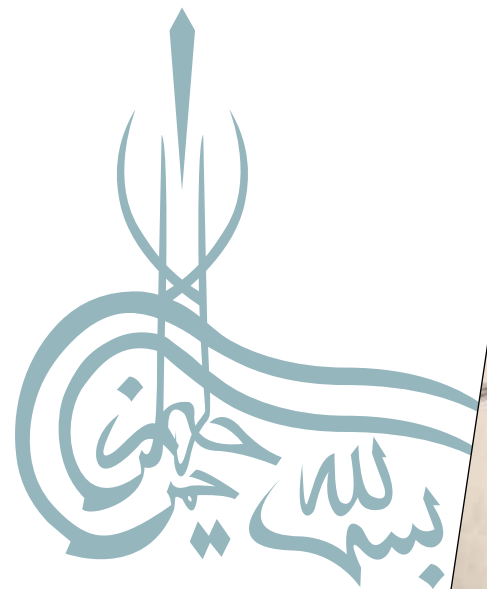
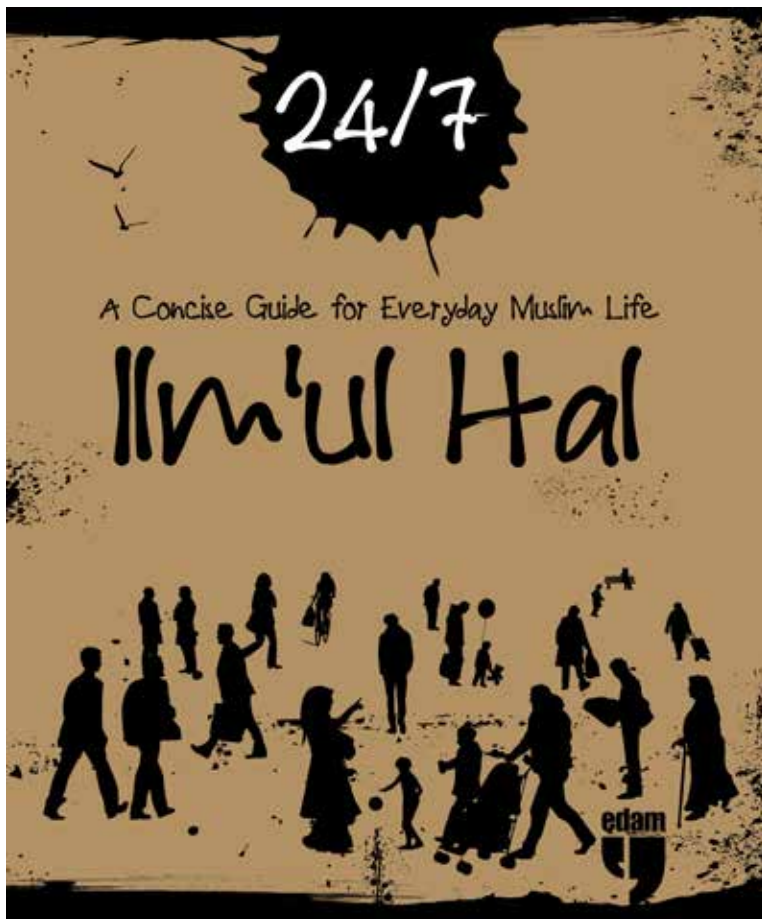

## How Does Someone Become a Prophet?

One does not decide to become a prophet. Allah (swt) chooses His messengers from among the people. With the last Prophet Muhammad (saw), Allah (swt) declared that He would not send any other messengers.

Muhammad is not a father of any of your men, but he is a messenger of Allah and the last of the prophets. And Allah has the Knowledge of everything. (Al-Ahzab, 33/40)

A Muslim who takes the prophets as examples in how to live his/her own life:

- ✓ Is just and fair.
- ✓ Is trusted in their words and actions. There is no contradiction between their words and how they live.
- ✓ Is patient and does not give up easily. No difficulties can discourage them.
- ✓ Will make the best of any occupation and will not be manipulative or unjust to anyone.
- ✓ Will be kind and do favours. They will refrain from any wrongdoings and will not put themselves in situations where things that are displeasurable to Allah (swt).
- ✓ Will love what Allah (swt) loves and refrain from whatever Allah (swt) dislikes.
- ✓ Does not hesitate to tell the truth in any situation. They will continue to do tabligh (spread the message) as the prophets did.

## Where and How to Behave? aadabul muasharat (etiquettes of social life)

Woe to every backbiter, deceiver (Al-Hamasa, 10/17)

Prophet Muhammad (saw) made dua after eating. Here is one of the duas he made:

الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي  
أَطْعَمَنِي هَذَا وَرَزَقَنِيهِ  
مِنْ غَيْرِ حَوْلٍ مِنِّي وَلَا قُوَّةِ

**Transliteration:** Alhamdulillah lillahillico 'a' amani hadha wa razaqanihi min ghayri hawlin minnee wa la quwwatin.

**Translation:** Praise is to Allah who has given me this food and sustained me with it though I was unable to do it and powerless. (Tirmidhi, Book 48, Hadith 89)

Allah enjoins to do justice and to adopt good behavior and to give relatives (their due rights), and forbids shameful acts, evil deeds and oppressive attitude. He exhorts you, so that you may be mindful. (An-Nail, 16/90)

In the presence of three people, two should not hold secret counsel, to the exclusion of the third. (Bukhari, Book 75, Hadith 62).

Whoever believes in Allah and the Last Day should speak a good word or remain silent. And whoever believes in Allah and the Last Day should show hospitality to his neighbour. And whoever believes in Allah and the Last Day should show hospitality to his guest. (Bukhari, Book 78, Hadith 163)



## Second Rakah

Recite the Basmala then read Surah al-Fatiha, followed by any other surah or a few ayat.

✓ Recite **Allahu Akbar** then proceed to ruku. The following dhikr should be recited in ruku three times:

**Subhana Rabbiyal 'Azem**  
"Free from all defects is my Lord, and in His praise I bow".

✓ After ruku, stand up straight with hands by your side and recite **Sami'**.  
**Allahu Liman hamidah** "Allah listens to one who praises Him". Then say **Kabbana lakal Hamd** "Our sustainer all praise is for you."

✓ Next say **Allahu Akbar**. Then proceed to go into sajdah.

✓ The following dhikr should be recited in sajdah three times:

**Subhana Rabbiyal 'Ala**  
"Glory be to my Great Sustainer, Most High, and I praise Him".

✓ After the first sajdah say **Allahu Akbar** and sit for a short period of time.

✓ Repeat the sajdah again by saying **Allahu Akbar**.

✓ Again recite the following dhikr in sajdah three times: **Subhana Rabbiyal 'Ala**. Say: **Allahu Akbar**

✓ After the sajdah following the second rakah, sit on your knees. Place your hands to rest on the thighs (Qaidah).

✓ As you sit recite at-tahiyyat, **Salat alan Nabi** and the **Rabbana duas**.

✓ Next turn your head towards your right shoulder and say:

**Assalamu alaikum wa rahmatullah** then turn your head towards your left shoulder and repeat the same **Assalamu alaikum wa rahmatullah**. This completes the prayer.

Abulhasan bin Ali bin reported that the Messenger of Allah (saw) said: "Whoever performs any prayer in congregation, let him perform it in congregation in the right shoulder and one who performs the last prostration in congregation, let him do it in the right shoulder. Salute the whole right." (Sunan Abu Dawud, 4/146)

## The Fard of Salat Fajr

✓ Men recite the Qasamat prior to the fard.

✓ Make the niyyah: You can say: "I have turned towards Kaaba (Qiblah) intending to pray the fard of Salat Fajr for the sake of Allah."

✓ The fard salah is performed exactly the same way as the sunnah.
